For several years the Fuentes' expanded their ministry to overseeing 9 churches in Mexico, 2 churches in the United States, and 60 home churches in Cuba. Over the years God has opened many opportunities for Ernesto and Olga to preach and teach in Puerto Rico, Dominican Re-

public, El Salvador, Honduras, Guatemala, and of course Mexico.

In addition to the leading, teaching, preaching, and writing mentioned above, the Fuentes have also run a camp, clinic, community development program, and child sponsorship program.
